A new season kicks off on the 15th of February with plenty to look forward to. The brown tags have been lifted, so usual service resumes with the blue tags. However, we cannot stress enough how important it is to record your fish as rod caught fish are taken as 15% of the total in the river. A few issues were raised with the old club permit system as a result some changes have taken place for the coming season. The permits themselves have been shrunk to make them easier to store in a top pocket. Also the club will be issuing a tag with permits this year, this tag is to be worn on your jacket or hat where it is clearly visible. This is a visual aid to help fishery officers, water keepers and anglers alike to identify whether someone should be fishing or not. **We must stress this is not a licence you must still carry your permit.**

This season we have also decided to put the fishery officer, Dermot Long's number on the permit so you have absolutely no excuse for not calling him if you see something suspicious. Neither we as a club nor the fishery officers want any confrontations between anglers and poachers we only ask you report immediately what you see, and also observe for as long as possible to aid water keepers and fishery officers. New water keepers have been appointed this season.

The club would like to stress that it is fully behind the protection of businesses from flooding in Bandon town!

The three nights set aside for the purchase of club permits are..... the pin on cards will also be handed out on these nights. These nights do not entitle any angler to fish without a permit. A specific club mobile no has been set up 0863724358 this will be in the possession of myself or Fergal at all times if you fail to contact us you will be put through to voice mail giving further instructions.

The A.G.M was very well attended this year and allot of important issues were raised and discussed.
